Then in the year of 2013 I was inducted into the Bakersfield country music family. All of this was able to happen due to the many people that gave me encouragement. However, it was just not other people that made me want to push myself all the way. It was having my own willpower to not give up when the times got tough for me.

In 2015 I was able to put a band of my own together to perform at various places around the Bakersfield community and once in Fresno. The band had a good run, and it gave me a sense of purpose in my life. Unfortunately a year later the band fell apart.
